











## AquaStone<sup>®</sup> (Basic Application)

Products: AquaStone®, SeatCoat Clear®

- TOOIS: Faux Effects® Trowels, 1/4" Nap Roller, Pounce Brush, Spray Bottle, Sanding Block (Medium Grit)
- Prep.Apply over a properly prepare substrate. Apply a coat of best quality<br/>latex paint or Faux Effects® SetCoat® in white. Let dry.
- Step 1. Thin AquaStone<sup>®</sup> with 10% water so it can be pounced on. When thinned properly, the loaded pounce brush will hold steep peaks.
- Step 2. Apply 1/8" thick layer of AquaStone<sup>®</sup> with a pounce brush creating high and low peaks of the material.
- $step\ 3.$  Spritz entire surface with a fine mist of water.
- Step 4. Using a Faux Effects<sup>®</sup> Trowel, with minimal pressure knock down the peaks to replicate embedded stone. Let dry (at least overnight).
- Step 5. Lightly sand the AquaStone<sup>®</sup> until any harsh abrasiveness is removed. This is a quick step. Sand just to make it feel smooth to the touch. Be sure to remove all dust after sanding.
- Step 6. Seal with SetCoat Clear<sup>®</sup>. Allow to dry at least overnight. Surface must be sealed to resist staining and to accept further finishing techniques.
